Ersem Manisa Received Safe Workplace Certificate

Ersem Manisa, one of the OYAK Mining Metallurgy companies was entitled to receive the "Safe Workplace Certificate" organized by the Yunusemre District Governorship in line with the decision taken in the Manisa Governorship Provincial General Hygiene Board. Ersem Manisa, one of the four facilities of Erdemir Steel Service Center (Ersem), had become the first company in its sector to have TSE Covid-19 Safe Production Certificate.

Acting in line with the guidelines of relevant institutions, especially the World Health Organization, Ersem Manisa has implemented a series of practices that prioritize the health of its employees and stakeholders, along with creative and good practices for distance, hygiene and mask use in all common areas.
